



INTERNET USER POLICY

Students are provided with a substantial allowance per month that gives them a free download capacity. If this amount is consumed in a given month access will cease.

Students are then required to purchase Internet Credits. This can be done through the Attendance Office.

In certain subjects, students are required to make heavy use of the Internet for research purposes. This is particularly true in certain Information Technology and Senior School subjects. Subject charges include internet access; hence access will be given when required.

There are certain education sites that students can access for a minimal charge. Teachers need to notify the Curriculum Network Manager before students begin to access such sites.

Before using the Internet students must check the value of their remaining credits. If a download results in the allowance being exceeded, students will be required to pay for any excess.

Duncraig Senior High School is a BYOD environment. Students should download the user guide for further information and detailed steps on how to connect their device to the Internet at Duncraig Senior High School. It is a requirement for connection to the school network that a user agreement is signed and returned.
