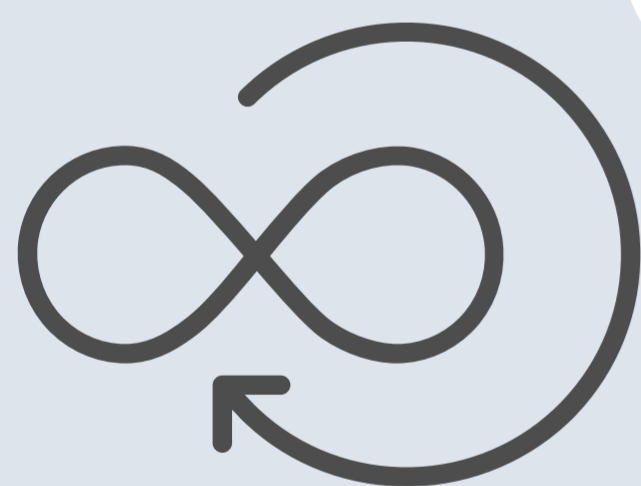


# TEACHING AND LEARNING MODEL

CHECK FOR UNDERSTANDING



FULL PARTICIPATION

## LEARNING OUTCOME



Clear goals that clarify what success looks like

### Teacher actions:

- Verbal or written outcome in every lesson
- Link to clear success criteria

### Student actions:

- Listen and/or record learning outcome in every lesson

## ESSENTIAL REVIEW



Regularly revise critical content

### Teacher actions:

- Activate prior knowledge and/or revisit previous critical content

### Student actions:

- Complete review task/s
- Ask clarifying questions

## MODEL



Demonstrate, guide and support new skills or concepts

### Teacher actions:

- Demonstrate through teacher-led instruction
- Use multiple modes for delivery
- Scaffold task appropriately

### Student actions:

- Actively observe and participate
- Ask clarifying questions
- Respond to feedback

## PRACTICE



Demonstrate and apply understanding of the skill or concept

### Teacher actions:

- Relate to learning outcome
- Provide regular feedback
- Provide work that challenges students
- Re-teach if concept/skill not understood

### Student actions:

- Actively observe and participate
- Ask clarifying questions
- Respond to feedback

## REFLECT



Evaluate success against the learning outcome

### Teacher actions:

- Check student understanding against success criteria
- Plan for future learning that addresses student needs

### Student actions:

- Self-reflect against success criteria
- Seek assistance if needed
