

STUDENT DRESS CODE

The Department of Education Policy on school dress code allows schools to make the wearing of school uniform a requirement. The School Board has endorsed a dress code for all students attending this school. The School Board believes a school dress code:

- fosters and enhances the public image of the school
- assists in building school and team spirit
- ensures students are safely dressed for specific school activities
- · encourages equality among students
- prepares students for the workplace, as many workplaces have dress and safety codes and expectations.

Items Available

School branding required on all items

- White polo shirt with collar (female and unisex fits)
- Physical education shirt with house colour (unisex fit)
- Pleated navy-blue skirt (female fit)
- Sports skort (female fit)
- Microfibre shorts (male and female fit)
- Physical education shorts (unisex fit)
- Track pant (unisex fit)
- Rugby jersey navy blue (unisex fit)
- Rugby jersey striped Years 10-12 only (unisex fit)
- Leaver jackets Year 12s only (unisex fit)
- Unisex track top (unisex fit)
- Unisex track top fleece lined (unisex fit)

No leggings are to be worn under clothes; however, plain navy-blue stockings are acceptable if worn underneath school skirt or shorts.

Skirts and shorts must be visible under school shirts and jumpers

NOTE: A plain white shirt may be worn beneath the school uniform for additional warmth.

Physical Education (PE) Uniform

Students may wear their house PE shirt to school if PE is first period of the day. For PE in Period 2 and onward, students will need to change into their house PE shirt. Students can wear their house PE shirt home if PE was the last session of the day.

Clarifications

What colour undershirt can be worn?

Plain white shirts only, no jumpers or hoodies.

Are the blue physical education shirts able to be worn?

This is no longer to be worn, the transition period ended at the end of 2023.

Are leggings able to be worn for dance?

Yes, so long as this is changed into school uniform after class.

Are girls able to wear both the skirt with inbuilt shorts and the PE skort?

Yes, so long as the skirts have our logo, then they can be worn anytime.

Are boys able to wear PE shorts all the time, or must they change to the microfibre ones?

Yes, so long as the shorts have our logo, then they can be worn anytime.

Are the cargo pants able to be worn?

This is no longer to be worn, the transition period ended at the end of 2023.

Is the windcheater able to be worn?

This is no longer to be worn, the transition period ended at the end of 2023.

Safety Requirements

- It is a safety requirement that students attending Design and Technology, Home Economics and Science classes wear covered footwear.
- Footwear: No thongs, health sandals, 'Ugg' style boots or any shoes deemed to be unsafe.

School Uniform Management

Students unable to meet the Student Dress Code on a given day are required to report to Student Services before school with a valid reason. Their names will be recorded and they will be issued with a Uniform Infringement Notice. Students may be requested to change into school uniform provided by Student Services.

Students who attend classes out of uniform and without a Uniform Infringement Notice will be issued with a Uniform Infringement Notice by their class teacher and have their names forwarded to the Student Services.

After **two** Uniform Infringement Notices, students will be placed on detention at lunchtime. This will occur for each and every infringement thereafter.

Repeat offenders will be referred to Student Services Manager by their Year Coordinator and further consequences may be enacted.
